Using Your Controls

Buttons and commands from left to right:

First Row:

Logout

Pause AIW

Settings

Help

Second Row:

End Session

Pause Video

Show Names

Snap

Third Row:

Hide Video

Medium

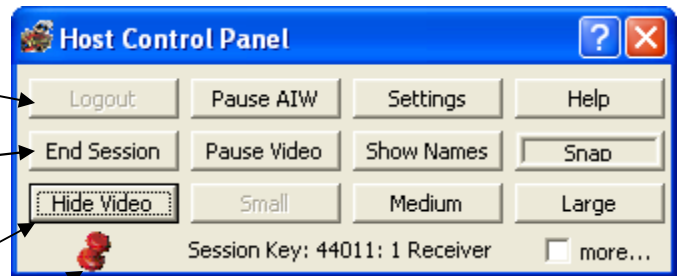

Bottom Row:

Pin

Session Key: Receiver

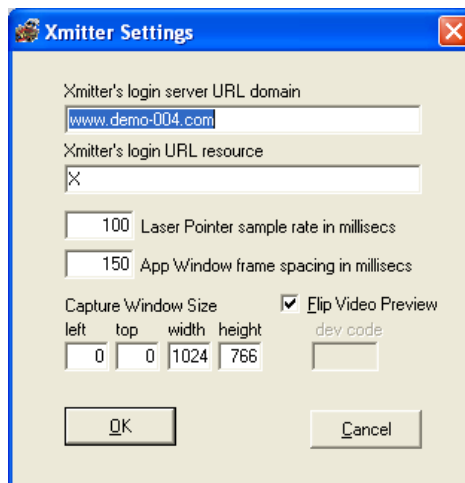
First Row Control Description

Log Out: log out of the session

Pause AIW: Pause application in window. This will pause your capture screen but your webcam will remain active.

Settings: Shows your settings

Help: Standard Help



How to Use SeeMore Controls

Second Row Control Description

End Session: Ends the current session. You need to end the session first and then Log Out

Pause Video: Pauses the webcam transmission.

Show Names: Shows the Guest Nicknames of the guests connected to the session.

Snap: If you click on snap, and drag it to an application window, the application you are working with will fit to the screen and your guest will be able to see the entire window.

Third Row Control Description

Hide Video: Hides webcam from view (turns it off)

Small: Shows small video window

Medium: Shows medium video window

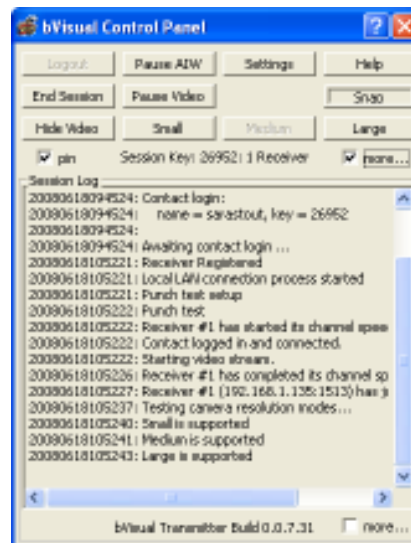
Large: Shows large video window

Bottom Row Control Description.

Pin: If you click on the pin, the control panel will stay visible. If not, it will hide until you mouse over the upper left corner of the capture screen window.

Session Key: Shows the active session's key. This is the session key that users will need to be a guest to your session. You will also see the number of receivers that are connected to your session.

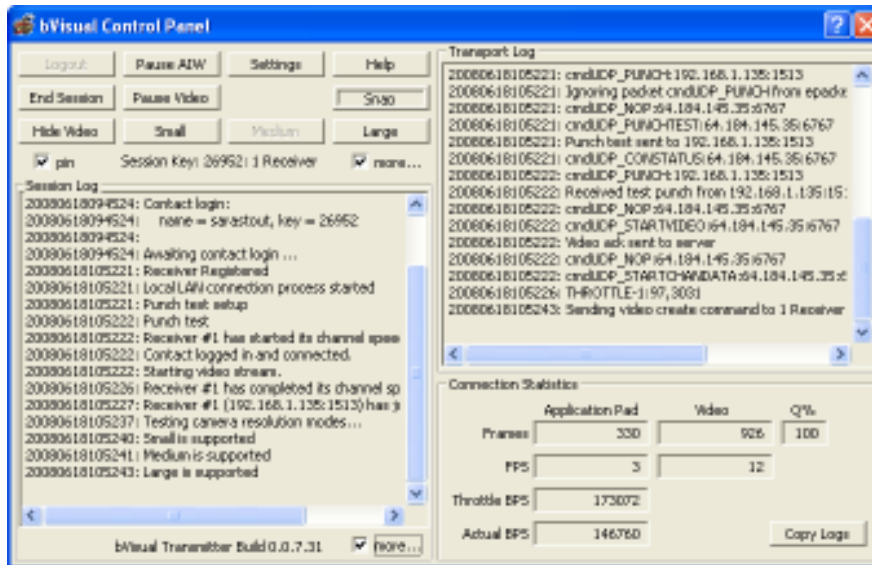
More: If you click in this box, another box will pop up with technical data.



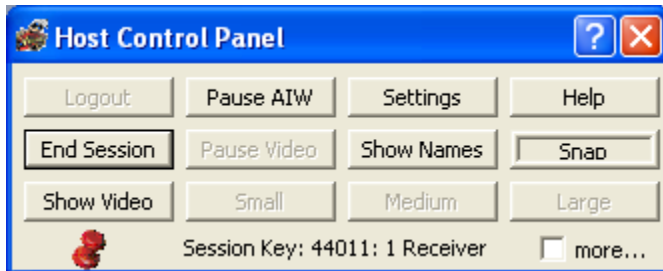
How to Use SeeMore Controls

If you click the second “more” box, it opens an additional section of technical data.

In this window you will see a “Copy Logs” button. You would click this if there were ever an issue. It sends technical data to our tech department for trouble shooting.



If you wish to end a session. Click the “End Session” Button.



Then click “Log Out”
